- ~ I will remain in my seat unless Mr. Amplo gives me permission to leave my seat.





MATH 8

We will be using Carnegie Learning Math Series Course 3. The Accelerated Class (Period 5) will be using Carnegie Learning Integrated Math I in addition to Course 3. This curriculum is aligned to the Common Core standards. All pre-requisite skills will be reviewed throughout the course of the year to fill in any gaps that may have occurred with the adoption of the new standards.

All students will be able to sign-in to their MathiaX Account as well as the Carnegie Resource Center through their school CLEVER account.


Students will receive THREE (3) Carnegie/MathiaX grades per trimester counting toward 10% of their overall grade:

- COMPLETION It is expected that students complete all the assigned modules corresponding with the textbook curriculum.
- Accuracy A percentage based on the number of correctly answered questions without hints or multiple attempts.
- MATHIAX NOTEBOOK Students MUST keep a SEPARATE notebook showing all work for each workspace question completed. This notebook should contain all equations solved, showing step-by-step procedures.

In addition to the textbook, supplemental material/handouts will be provided throughout the course of the school year.

As with all math classes, the skills build upon each other. If a key skill is missed or you are having difficulty grasping any of the material, it is your responsibility to seek help or ask for assistance as soon as possible. Waiting till the end of the trimester will not instantaneously fix all the problems that have accumulated over the previous weeks.

Make sure you come to tutoring!



SUPPLIES

- CHROMEBOOK: Students are required to bring their FULLY CHARGED, school-issued Chromebook and charger each day. Chromebooks are equipped with DESMOS, which can be used as a scientific calculator.
- AGENDA: Every student should keep a weekly agenda. It does not have to be an official JWMS Agenda. You may use a digital/online agenda if you prefer.
- 3) CLASS NOTEBOOK: ONE notebook should be used specifically for this class. Multi-subject notebooks are not allowed. This notebook will be collected each trimester for grading. You may use it for open notebook tests when allowed.
- 4) MathiaX NOTEBOOK:

This notebook is to be used specifically for solving and showing work with the online software.

- 5) 3-RING BINDER: Each student should have a 3-ring binder or folder to hold current textbook chapters. This must be brought to class daily.
- 6) PENCILS, PENS, & ERASERS: All students should come prepared with at least TWO (2) sharpened pencils each day. Pencil sharpening may take place BEFORE or AFTER class, but NOT DURING CLASS.
